Re: CITA Extends China Safeguard Decisions

---

On September 30, 2005, the Committee for the Implementation of Textile Agreements (“CITA”) announced that it is extending the period of time until November 30, 2005, to determine whether to request consultations with China with respect to the following goods:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Description</u>
345/645/646	Cotton & Man-Made Fiber Sweaters
350/650	Cotton & Man-Made Fiber Dressing Gowns & Robes
447	Men’s & Boy’s Wool Trousers
222	Knit Fabric

If the CITA requests consultations, China must immediately restrict the importation of the above mentioned goods to a level no greater than 7.5% (6% for wool products) above the amount entered during the first twelve (12) months of the most recent fourteen (14) months preceding the request.
